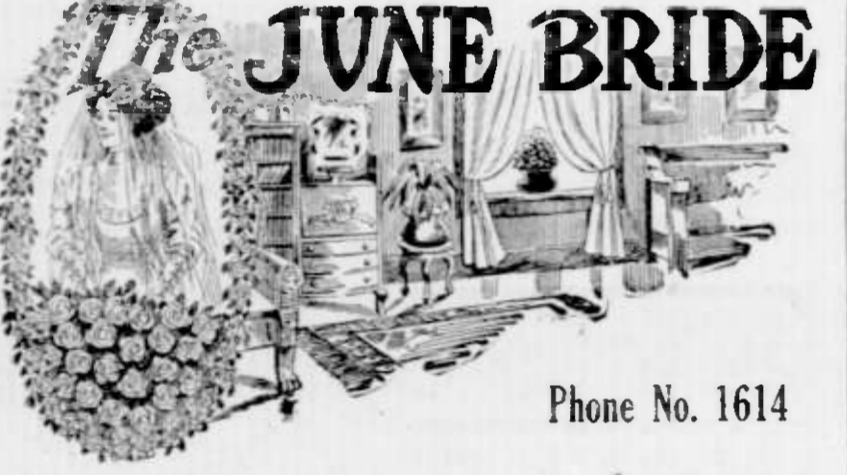

Miss Tillie Schaefer is on the sick list. Gregor Schmitz raised his new barn last Thursday.

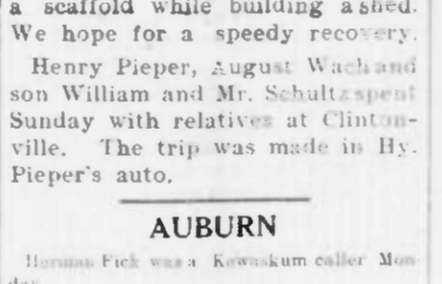

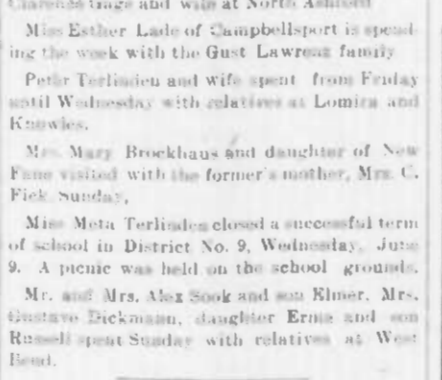

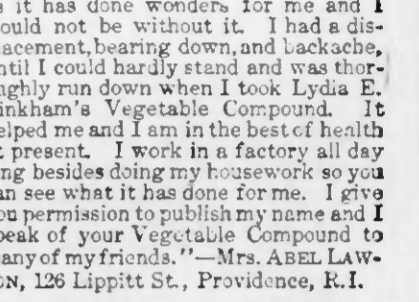
