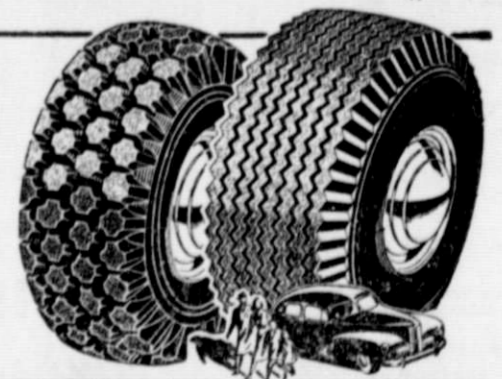

With funds received through the sale, the WATA finances the taking and reading of x-rays, tuberculin skin tests, patient rehabilitation, medical social service and general education on tuberculosis through the distribution of literature. A new service has been the annual series of tuberculosis control institutes held in various cities throughout Wisconsin.

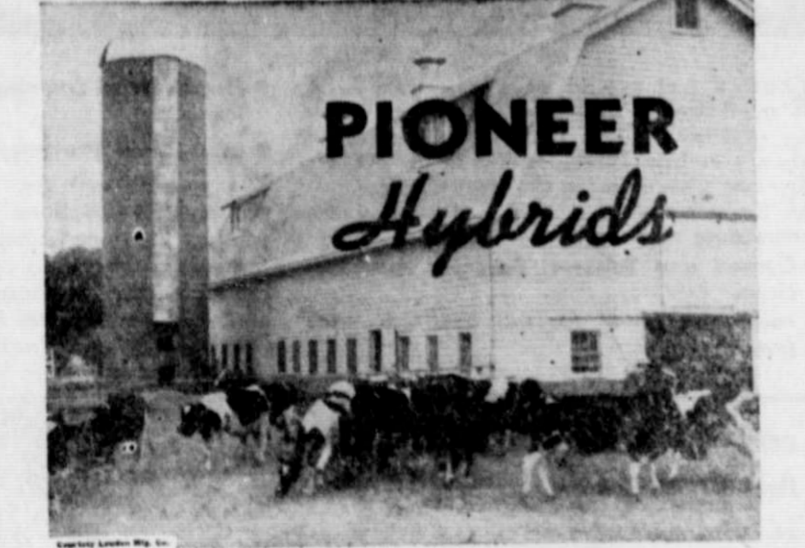
