## Miller Studio and Electric Sold; To Open Village Store

On Nov. 4, Charles F. and Mary M. Miller of Miller Studio and Electric consummated a transaction with Carl and Jane Spoeth, new residents of 1189 River View Dr., Kewaskum, and Karl and Ann Fee of Atlanta, Ga., in which they acquired the original building that Charles Miller, druggist, constructed in 1874. Thus ends the period in Kewaskum history in which the Miller family (Charles, 1874-1913; Edward C., 1913-1937; Charles F., 1937-1975) have lived at and operated the store at 334-336 Main St.

In an age of computers, giant corporations and directionless people, there are still a few places where people are still people and life has direction and meaning. In the minds of Carl and Jane Spoeth and Karl and Ann Fee, Kewaskum is one of those places.

It is here that they plan to open the Village Store, a throwback to a simpler, less complicated era. Acquiring the Miller studio as the store site, they are now working on the interior layout and

inventory the store will carry. Much attention is being given to creating an authentic turn of the century general store, including the old fashioned courtesy and service associated with the days gone by. The hours of operation and merchandise will serve both the community and visitors to the Kettle Moraine State Park. Depending on the time it takes to refurbish and stock the store, plans anticipate the store opening early in the new year.

Charles and Mary do thank the people of Kewaskum and the surrounding area for their friendship and patronage over these last 38 years. Kewaskum is a good place to live and work and the Millers are especially pleased that the new owners, the Spoeths and Fees, feel the same way about life in Kewaskum.

## Sex Discrimination Comes Up for Discussion at School Board Meeting

Title IX of the Federal Regulations, which deals with sex discrimination, came in for discussion at the Kewaskum Board of Education meeting Monday evening. Prompting the discussion were a request for a coach of girls' track at the Middle School and an administration decision to not allow girls to participate in boys' basketball this year.

Approval was given to hiring a coach for the girls' track team this spring. An attempt will also be made to provide some basketball and volleyball games for the girls through the winter as part of the intramural program. Allen Tessar mentioned that he had heard that someone had indicated to the parents or students that not allowing the girls to participate on the boys basketball team was a board decision. He asked that notification be sent to everyone to be sure that the source of decisions is accurately stated.

JoAnne LaFleur and her parents were present to discuss her plan to enter college after her junior year. She requested that the board approve granting a high school diploma upon completion of her first college year. This was agreed to provided that a social studies course be included in that first year to complete a high school required course.

A Title II resolution was passed allowing the district to apply for federal funds for library and audio-visual

materials.

Approval was given to purchase control gates for the Wayne and Farmington schools, but the question of added safety bars on the backboards at the high school was delayed for possible future action.

Byron Gessner, Jerry Secor and Richard Theusch were re-appointed to the teacher negotiating committee. The board also decided to contract with the Wisconsin Association of School Boards to provide the services of a negotiator.

Richard Theusch was named as delegate to the WASB convention in January. Allen Tessar was named alternate.

Contract approval of Lawrence Van Beek as elementary school librarian was delayed because the board wished to discuss the appointment in executive session. Since no action could be taken following the executive session, a special meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, Nov. 12, 1975 at 8 p. m. to act on the contract.

The board cancelled its second November meeting unless there is business which must be transacted prior to the regular December meeting.

Allen Tessar asked that Clark Pearson check on why the high school library has been closed at times.

The board adjourned to executive session to discuss student and staff personnel questions.

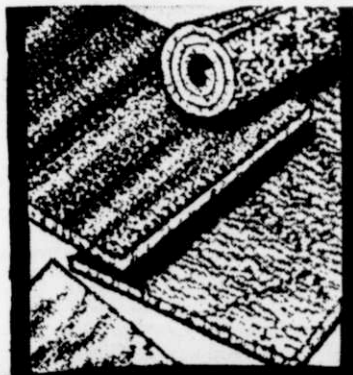

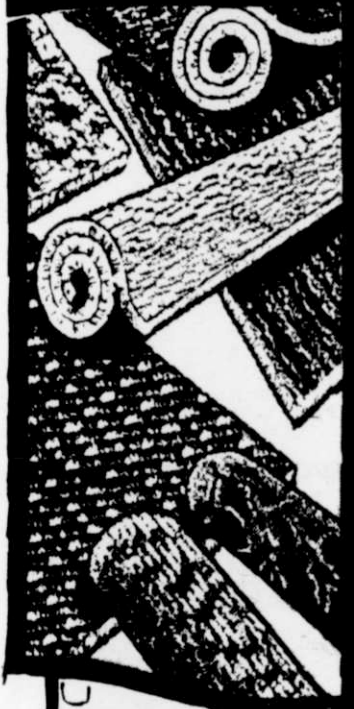

## Co-Champion Indians Place 5 on Scenic All-Conference Team

Kewaskum, which shared the Scenic Moraine Conference football title with Grafton with a 6-1 record, placed five players on the all-conference first team. Voting by coaches took place last Wednesday evening at a fall sports meeting in Kewaskum.

Seven of the eight Scenic Moraine schools (all except Slinger) are represented on the first unit. Seniors dominated the team. Kewaskum players on the first team included four on the offensive unit and one on defense. Co-champion Grafton had only two players selected, both on defense. Hartland was represented by the most players, six, while Germantown had four, Kettle Moraine three, and Mayville and Pewaukee, one each.

The Indians, who led the conference in offense with 168 points and 2,044 yards rushing and close to 2,200 combined, placed end Jack Kern, guard Jack Westerman, tackle Keith Mueller and back Dennis Bremser. On defense, nose guard Gary Gavin was picked. He is a junior.

Kern, at 6-2 and 200 lbs., was one of only two unanimous choices out of 22 selected. Jack caught 9 passes totaling 130 yards for 2 touchdowns and 3 extra points. He also blocked well.

Westerman, 5-8 and 185, and Mueller, 5-11 and 195, have played side by side the

past 2 seasons and unofficially they have blocked for over 4,500 yards for Indian backs. Both are excellent blockers and sometimes had their men pushed back 7 to 10 yards.

Bremser, 5-10 and 160, was Mr. Versatility for the Indians as he kicked off, took care of extra point kicking, made 2 of 3 field goals, including the one that beat Germantown in the last 5 seconds, played defense, and besides found time to run the football for over 600 yards in 7 conference games. Dennis had the best average per carry in the league, that being 8.0 yards every time he carried.

Gavin, picked as an interior lineman on defense, has played nose guard for Kewaskum for the past 2 seasons and is only a junior. He has the distinction of being the only junior picked on the first team. Gary had a fine year, blocking 3 kicks, coming up with 4 fumbles, and averaged at least 12 to 15 tackles a game.

Five Kewaskum players also received honorable mention. They are: Offense—Jim Bilgo, quarterback, and Dave Menzel, back; defense—Menzel, line, Tom Rohlinger, linebacker, and John Seweres, linebacker.

The Indians, which used the Wishbone, were basically a running team.
